

## ADDENDUM TO SEPA THRESHOLD DETERMINATION

**DESCRIPTION OF NON-PROJECT ACTION:** On May 30, 2006, Skagit County adopted Resolution number R20060184. The resolution amended the schedule of the Skagit County owned and operated Guemes Island Ferry, which runs between Anacortes and Guemes Island by adding five additional runs (at 6:30 p.m., 7:00 p.m., 8:30 p.m., 9:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m.) on Monday through Thursday. The pre-existing scheduled runs on Monday through Thursday (from 6:30 a.m. to 5:45 p.m.), Friday and Saturday (from 6:30 a.m. to 12:00 midnight), and Sunday and holidays (from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.) were essentially unchanged. The action is intended to address existing and future demand for ferry service and is not expected to impact future land use decisions or result in a need for additional terminal space, dock improvements, parking, or road improvements. The schedule change is a non-project action that is subject to review under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA).

**PROPONENT/LEAD AGENCY:** Skagit County Public Works, Ferry Division/Skagit County.

**APPLICABILITY:** The action, Skagit County Resolution number R20060184, amends the schedule for the Guemes Island Ferry, which provides vehicular and passenger service between Anacortes and Guemes Island.

**TITLE OF DOCUMENT:** Resolution number R20060184, A Resolution Amending the Guemes Island Ferry Departure Schedule.

**FINDINGS:** Skagit County, the lead agency for this action, has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required. RCW 43.21C.030(2)(C). A determination of non-significance (DNS) was issued on July 27, 2007. This addendum adds information about the action but does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts or alternatives in the existing environmental document. This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

**COMMENT PERIOD:** This project does not fall under any of the proposals listed under WAC 197-11-340(2); therefore, under WAC 197-11-625(5), a comment period is not required for this addendum.


**APPEAL PERIOD:** There is no administrative appeal for this determination of non-significance.
